Mobility program

On Sunday:

All the different partner countries arrived at Cluj airport and got picked up by a minibus. Then they were taken to the school where all the host families were waiting for the students. The teachers were brought to the hotel.

On Monday

All the delegations met at the school Liceul Borsa and were welcomed by the headmaster of the school, the teachers, students and the mayor of Borsa. The groups were presented to Romanian culture and the region of Borsa. Then the students presented their schools, their results of the questionnaire and gave presentations on water and culture, and the relationship of water from antiquity to the present day, water and health, water and economy, protection of natural water resources and mineral water.

On Tuesday

We drove to different water springs to get water samples in the morning. In the afternoon the students worked with the water samples finding out about smell, taste etc.

On Wednesday

Sightseeing tour to Horse Waterfall in the morning. Having lunch at a different place. Students doing a workshop where they produced drinks with local fruit sirup and the water samples. Later giving a feedback about their impressions of Romania.

On Thursday

Trip to the "Happy Cemetery" in Sapanta and to the Sapanta-Peri Monastery (the highest wooden construction in Europe. In the afternoon we had the ARK Ceremony at the townhall of Borsa.

On Friday

All the delegations departed from Cluj airport, respectively Norway on Saturday.

Teachers' agreements:

Concerning all partners:

1. The program of each country should include a time schedule (overview) for each day. Also adding sth. for teachers.
2. 4 week before the next meeting will take place the hosting country sends the program and the calculated budget to the other teams. If it is not possible to pay with credit card, one has to specify the payment.
3. There has to be a teambuilding activity at the beginning of the program, meaning Mondays, so that the students get to know each other and mix
4. The Erasmus Plus Logo as well as the project's logo should be included in powerpoint presentations
5. The students will work on their presentation skills (free speech, including videos where possible, only have key words on slides and telling extra information....)
6. Host countries create a 1-page vocabulary list on their topic and send it to the other countries 4 week before the next meeting will take place
7. Teachers prefer hotels close to city center if it is possible, using public transport is ok for everybody,
8. Every team has to send the matching profiles for the next two mobilities to Norway and Germany (if you already have more matching profiles also for the other mobilities) within two weeks after our meeting in Romania ended
9. Each student group traveling should prepare an introduction video of each student to be uploaded on Twinspace 4 weeks ahead of the meeting or earlier
10. Each team prepares a Christmas surprise for another team like cookies, Christmas cards or sth. typical of their country at Christmas time, until December 13th (here: do not tell the students which country will prepare their surprise!!): Romania→Poland→Norway→Germany→Latvia→Italy→Romania
11. Atmosfair.com or an alternative company: each group will compensate at least one mobility with atmosfair or an alternative company, sharing the certificate with all the others to be uploaded on Twinspace, Facebook, Homepage ...
12. Every country has to create a google form questionnaire based on Norway's Microsoft word document questionnaire, having at least 60 people answering the questionnaire at home, uploading it on Twinspace, then print out the answers (with the pie charts) 5 times (for each of our students) and bring it to Norway, so that they can discuss their results with international teams there.
13. All the partners will fill in the needed content on Mobility Tool by November 30th
14. The diary entries (for the navigation book) should be 1 page, Arial Writing Type, headlines in 14, text in 12 size

Norway:

- Norway creates a questionnaire about composting 4 weeks in advance of our next meeting in Microsoft Word and send it to all partner countries; all the team members (students) will be and work in mixed groups and each students should be able and present their results of their country discussing e.g. what are the differences in the countries, what are the advantages from the other countries' teams, maybe even working out a presentation???
- Using quizilet.com students will work with the vocabulary and play it in Norway

- Norway: works out the program for the next mobility
- One Norwegian student will write a diary entry about Wednesday the 6th of November

Italy:

- Italy prepares navigation book with vocabulary section, diary entries of students and pictures (for Romania: Arrival Day: Germany/Monday: Latvia/Tuesday: Norway/Wednesday: Poland/Thursday: Italy/Friday: Romania/) until our next meeting in Norway, so that we can discuss it.
- An Italian student will write a diary entry about Friday the 8th of November

Germany:

- Will establish the homepage until December 31st and update the homepage with everything we have done/worked out/pictures etc.
- One German student will write a diary entry about arrival day and it will be sent to Italy

Latvia:

- Creates a video about our first mobility and will update our Facebook group with the contents of our first mobility
- One Latvian student will write a diary entry about Tuesday the 5th

Poland:

- Will create a leaflet with important information about water usage for different purposes and how to save water so that the results can be spread in all schools. It has to be ready in a week from now? Here trying the website: CANVA.com
- One Polish student will write a diary entry about Thursday the 7th

Romania:


- Updates our Twinspace with all the content of the 1st mobility
